### Faculty of Education



Dean of the Faculty Professor Dr. Muhammad Zafar Iqbal

Established in 1985, the Faculty of Education is the largest faculty of the university with 47% enrolment of the university and contribution of 55% to the total annual university exchequer. At present 30 programmes and 135 courses in its eight departments/institutes are being run by the faculty. The programmes include P.T.C., C.T., Diploma in Education (10+3 mode), B.Ed., M.Ed., MA (Education), M.S.Ed., M.Phil, Special Education, MA EPM and MS/ M.Phil leading to Ph.D. Recently the faculty has been restructured to achieve the new standards of teacher education. The restructured departments include Department of Secondary Teacher Education (STED), Department of Distance, Non-Formal and Continuing Education (DNFCE), Department of Educational Planning, Policy Studies and Leadership (EPSSL), Department of Early Childhood Education & Elementary Teacher Education (ECE&ETE), Department of Special Education, Center for Curriculum Studies & Educational Assessment (CCEA), Department of Science Education and Institute of Literacy and Mass Education (ILME), Department of Women in Tailoring in Muzaffarabad, A.I.K. (COL) PROTEIN project, Establishment of Resource Centre for Adult Literacy (UNESCO), Women Education Project for Development of MA level course in women development (UNESCO), Establishment of National Centre of Curriculum Studies and Educational Assessment at AIOU (HEC), Development of Course Book on Education through series of lectures (Institute of Policy Studies), Development of Literacy Material (10 Modules UNESCO), and collaboration in the Literacy and Poverty Eradication programme (DAMP).

At present, the faculty is collaborating in at least 12 projects with these agencies for improving the quality of education. The Faculty is also integrating ICTs in the designing, developing and delivering of the courses. The faculty is also running a variety of postgraduate technical, scientific and professional programmes successfully. The Research Complex also has a Computer Lab with Internet and On-line Library facility, Seminar Room, Lecture Hall. In addition, there are labs for practical work, teaching and research, and instrumentation labs for analysis. The University is developing these labs through its own resources. The Faculty of Sciences is fortunate to have Prof. Dr. Mahmood ul Hasan Butt as the University's Vice-Chancellor, who has given personal attention to the development of the Faculty of Sciences by providing generous amount of funds and valuable guidance.

Two Model labs are also in the process of development in the Research Complex with the assistance of the Higher Education Commission to meet the training needs of science teachers. This development is significant since under the new educational policy four-year B.S. program has started in undergraduate educational institutions. More than fifty highly qualified full-time faculty members are on the roll of the Faculty of Sciences. Their role in the planning, designing and development of courses to meet students' needs is vital. The faculty members engage in imparting and supervising instructions so that high standards are maintained. In addition, highly qualified and experienced professors are also engaged on contract or as part time instructors for postgraduate study programmes. The Faculty is also offering academic positions under the tenure-track system to attract the best minds in scientific and technological fields.

Research is an integral part of the postgraduate study programmes leading to M.Sc., M. Phil., and Ph.D. degrees in Agricultural Sciences, Chemistry, Computer Sciences, Home and Health Sciences, Mathematics and Statistics and Physics. The Rules and regulations governing the postgraduate study programmes are those approved by the Higher Education Commission (HEC). Admissions to M.Phil/ Ph.D. are offered to those who pass GAT test of the National Testing Service (NTS) and the departmental interview.

For MS and M. Phil. degree, 24 credit hours of course work and a minimum of one year of research work in a specialized area of the discipline is required. A candidate for the Ph.D. degree has to take additional 18 credit hours of specialized courses in the field of research. Also a Ph.D. candidate has to pass the GRE (International) examination during the period of candidature for the degree. The dissertation will comprise original research on a topic in the discipline and shall be evaluated by three foreign referees who are expert in the field. At least one publication in international journal is also necessary before the degree is awarded.

The Faculty is launching B.S. program in Chemistry and Microbiology in the current semester. The four-year B.S. program is structured according to the recent policies of the Higher Education Commission for improvement of standard of education to bring it at par with the international standards.

### Faculty of Sciences

The Faculty of Sciences since its establishment in 1982 with five teaching departments has undergone major development changes. It now comprises one teaching and research departments which are offering courses at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels to more than ten thousand students. The Faculty works under the basic guidelines of the University Act and on 'Education for All as Convenient' basis so that maximum students could get benefit from its academic programmes and educational facilities. This principle has necessitated some structural changes in the non-formal mode, particularly at the postgraduate level, in the offering of theory courses and practical lab work. This conceptual adjustment has been quite successful and many in-service students are benefiting from postgraduate study programmes. Improvement in qualifications for a better life is a right of everyone and the faculty's programmes meet this challenge by offering opportunities to all so a significant number of beneficiaries are those who cannot afford education in formal institutions due to a variety of reasons.

Realizing the importance of science education and the growing needs of the Faculty of Sciences, the University has constructed a building, the Research Complex, at a cost of Rs. 35 million. The Research Complex now accommodates departments of Agricultural Sciences, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Sciences, Home & Health Sciences, Mathematics & Statistics and Physics. These departments are running a variety of postgraduate technical, scientific and professional programmes successfully. The Research Complex also has a Computer Lab

### Faculty of Social Sciences & Humanities

The Faculty of Social Sciences was established in 1982 a very small number of departments but with the passage of time and the growing needs, the number grew and now it has 15 departments. This Faculty has the following departments: Business Administration, Commerce, Commonwealth, MBA/MPA, Economics, English Language and Applied Linguistics, History, Pakistan Studies, Urdu, Mass Communication, Pakistani Languages and Literature, Iqbal Studies, Library and Information Sciences, Sociology (Social Work and Population Studies), and Gender and Women Studies, and Library Information Sciences.

The Faculty offers programmes and courses in different disciplines of social sciences and languages. It offers Postgraduate programmes in Iqbal Studies, Pakistani Languages and Literature, Urdu, Economics and Mass Communication. At master's level, the faculty offers programmes in Business Administration/Business Administration IT, COL Business Administration/Public Administration, Teaching of English as a Foreign Language, Pakistan Studies, Economics, Gender and Women Studies, Sociology, Mass Communication, History, Urdu, Library and Information Sciences (MIS). The Postgraduate Diploma level programmes like Teaching of English as a Foreign Language and Gender and Women Studies are also offered. At the graduate level, the Faculty offers BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration), B.Com, BA (General, Design, Fine Arts) and at certificate level, Certificate in Librarianship, HSSC (General & I.Com), SSC (General), and French Online.

Also the Faculty has made some important achievements which are as follows:-

- The Department of English Language & Applied Linguistics has signed an MOU with the HEC to establish a Self-Access Centre (SAC) at the main campus of the university. The SAC would be a center of excellence for instructors and researchers to share their expertise.
- The Department of Pakistani Languages has made all the arrangements for setting up a language laboratory for promotion of Pakistani Languages. The Department is also preparing educational documentaries on classical poets of all languages of Pakistan.

### Faculty of Arabic & Islamic Studies

The Faculty of Arabic & Islamic Studies was proposed in the Allama Iqbal Open University Parliament Act 1974. Initially it started as the Institute of Arabic and Islamic Studies comprising the departments of Arabic and Islamic Studies.

Later on, this institute was upgraded to the level of a full fledged faculty in 1999. After establishment of new academic departments, highly qualified faculty members were inducted. Presently foreign and local qualified teachers having PhD and M.Phil degrees in different fields of Islamic Studies are working in the Faculty.

The Faculty is playing a leading role in research as well as teaching activities in Pakistan. It is the only Islamic Studies Faculty Pakistani Universities which has a large number of candidates in Post Graduate programmes i.e. M.A., M. Phil and Ph.D. The Faculty has recently upgraded its curriculum and prepared schemes of studies and course outlines for BS 4 year degree programme in Islamic Studies, M.S. in Islamic Studies and Ph.D. in Islamic Studies with four specializations in Quran and Tafseer, Hadith & Seerah, Islamic Law, Islamic Thought, History & Culture.

Other than these academic activities, the Faculty has introduced through outreach programmes like Training programmes for University and Post-Graduate Colleges teachers. Conferences, seminars and symposiums of national and international levels are also sponsored by the Faculty. The research journal of the Faculty namely "MAARAF-E-ISLAM" has achieved high academic level and is recognized by HEC.

**Departments of the Faculty**  
The Faculty of Arabic and Islamic Studies comprises the following academic departments:

- Department of Quran and Tafseer**  
The department offers courses on Quran and Tafseer from Matric to MA levels in addition to MA Islamic Studies with specialization in Quran and Tafseer. It is also coordinating different courses of Islamic Studies at Matric, Intermediate and BA levels.
- Department of Hadith and Seerah**  
Advanced studies and research in the field of Hadith and Seerah are conducted by this department. It is also coordinating Ph.D. Islamic Studies programme, Dars-e-Nizami programmes from Matric to BA, and specialization in MA Islamic Studies is also offered.
- Department of Fiqh (Islamic Law and Jurisprudence)**  
This department conducts advanced research in the field of Islamic Law and Jurisprudence. To achieve this goal the department is offering graduate and postgraduate programmes and Specialization in Islamic Law in MA Islamic Studies.
- Department of Islamic Thought, History and Culture**  
Advanced studies and research in the field of Islamic Thought, History and Culture through its postgraduate programmes. The coordination of MA Islamic Studies, and M.Phil programmes are also done in this department. The department is also working on a project to collect data of Scholars of Islamic Studies working in different Universities of Pakistan.
- Department of Arabic Language and Literature**  
The department is offering programmes in Arabic such as Arabic Teacher Training Certificate (ATTC) and B.Ed Arabic, Basic Arabic courses, Intermediate and BA Arabic, MA Arabic, Arabic Bol Chat & Al-Lisan-ul-Arabi. Moreover, the department is offering Radio, TV graduate and postgraduate programmes by Direct Method and latest Techniques are used in it.
