**Q.No.1:** Critically analyze the concept of social problems by discussing various sociological perspectives such as functionalism, conflict theory, and symbolic interactionism. Q.No.1: Describe the major types of crime, such as violent crime, property crime, white-collar crime, and cybercrime, with suitable examples from Pakistani society. Discuss how factors like class, gender, age, and urbanization influence who commits crimes and why. Support your answer using sociological theories of deviance and crime. (20)

- **Q.No.2:** Analyze the role of mass media (including television, newspapers, and social media) in shaping public opinion in Pakistan.
