As per revised formula, securing passing marks in assignments/practical and other components is not compulsory w.e.f. Spring, 2023 onwards, however, passing marks i.e. 40% in final exams is mandatory. If a student gets 40 marks out of 100 in the final exams and does not score 50% aggregate marks, he/she will be declared Fail in the respective course and he/she will have to re-register/re-admit in the respective course, whenever said course (s) are offered in any of the subsequent semester (s).

ALLAMA IQBAL OPEN UNIVERSITY

Allama Iqbal Open University, (a mega university) was established in 1974 under an Act of Parliament. The main campus of the university is situated in sector H-8, Islamabad. It was the second open university of the world and the first of its kind in Asia. The aim of establishing AIOU was to provide affordable and accessible education through distance learning at the doorsteps to those people who could not continue their educational journey through formal system of education. The University (AIOU) operates on semester system and admits students in Autumn and Spring semesters. Under graduate admissions are being offered in both the semesters whereas post graduates are being offered once a year. The enrolled students are given course books specially prepared by the university based on self-instructional principles. However, at post graduate level reprints of foreign books, allied material with university prepared study guides help students to polish their skills.

At present, the AIOU is offering programmes from Matric to PhD level in diverse disciplines comprising four faculties. The university has established study centres across the country, where distance education students are provided necessary guidance by their respective tutors. Moreover, the university has established

full time completely Scientific Lab, the students of MBA (IT), MBA (Banking and Finance), BS (CS), MSc/BS Chemistry, MSc/BS Microbiology etc. are being provided instruction, guidance and counselling through face-to-face education. AIOU is offering four years under graduate degrees.

Apart from curricular activities during the academic year, the AIOU and its regional centres actively participate in the co-curricular activities by arranging educational and literary seminars, workshops and conferences, attended not only by the students and faculties of the university, but also by the renowned dignitaries and scholars. For the science students and research scholars, a science complex has been built where they use the latest state of the art equipment for experimentation and research. To meet the present-day challenges, internet facility is also available in the student's hostel and the Central Library, the where computers have been provided to enable students to access latest information available through open source databases.

FACULTY OF EDUCATION

The origin of the Faculty of Education pre-dates the university itself. The National Institute of Education was established in 1973 under the Federal Ministry of Education. It became part of the university in June, 1975 as Institute of Education in the Faculty of Social Sciences. The progressively extending functions of the Institute brought the needs for structural change and in 1984 it got the status of Faculty of Education.

DEPARTMENTS OF THE FACULTY

Faculty of Education comprises of the following six departments:

1. Distance, Non-Formal and Continuing Education
2. Educational Planning, Policy Studies and Leadership
3. Early Childhood Education and Elementary Teacher Education
4. Secondary Teacher Education
5. Science Education
6. Special Education

Distance, Non Formal & Continuing Education (DNFCE)

The department was established in 1984 and was renamed as Distance, Non Formal and Continuing Education in 2008. It offers specialized degree programmes/courses in Distance Non-Formal and Continuing Education, Adult Education and Educational Technology at, MPhil and PhD (MS/MPhil Based) level. It also offers courses at BA level.

Educational Planning, Policy Studies & Leadership (EPPSL)

The department was established in 1976 was renamed as EPPSL in 2008. It offers programmes in educational planning and management. These programmes are aimed at producing a cadre of professionals for the educational institutions and organizations in the country. Programmes of EPPSL include Postgraduate Diploma, MPhil and PhD (MS/MPhil Based). The courses of these programmes are attained to the field requirements of target personnel in the areas of educational planning and management.

Early Childhood Education and Elementary Teacher Education

The Department of Elementary Teacher Education was established in 2003. In April 2008, the name of Elementary Teacher Education Department was changed as Early Childhood Education and Elementary Teacher Education Department. The Early Childhood Education and Elementary Teacher Education Department offers ADE, PGD in ECE, BEd, MPhil and PhD programmes, it also offers “Education” as subject at Matric, Intermediate and Graduate level. Early Childhood Education and Elementary Teacher Education Department is one of the largest departments of this institution in terms of its enrollment of students and the number of courses offered by this department.

Secondary Teacher Education

The Department of Teacher Education was established in 1985 and was bifurcated into Secondary and Elementary Teacher Education Departments in July 2003. Its programmes aim at imparting academic and professional knowledge and training to in-services and pre service teachers and scholars.

Science Education

The Department of Science Education was established in 1988. The programmes and courses of the department are mainly focused on education and training of science teachers. Presently the department offers specialized courses in science at BEd, MPhil and PhD level. Specialization courses provide conceptual framework and in depth insight into the teaching of science effectively.

Special Education

The Department was established in 1985. The department imparts education and training to teachers for the special children in four specializations namely Visual impairment, Hearing impairment, Physical disabilities and Mental retardation with particular emphasis to facilitate mainstreaming of special children. Parents of the special children are also admitted to these programmes. Present programmes/courses of this department comprised of Postgraduate Diploma, MPhil and PhD (MS/MPhil Based) in Special Education.

Mission

B.Ed 1.5 in Special Education program's focus on education and training of prospective teachers and professionals aiming at the competency in subject matter as well as in teaching approaches to bring qualitative change in the field of Special education and rehabilitation of children with disabilities. Targeting the improvement in children's learning and experiences, the course focuses on preparing professional teachers to work in both special and inclusive education setup.

Introduction

B.Ed 1.5 in Special Education program is offered to students who have obtained their 16 years of Education degrees in any discipline other than Special Education. This program is intended for those master's degree holders who intend to enter the field of special education as a subject specialist. Usually, these students'

general education is not guided by any defined vocational purpose. The new B.Ed 1.5 in Special Education program will prepare them for significant roles expected from them in their teaching career. The program will be a composite program blending Core Courses, Foundation Courses, Professional Courses, and Specialization Courses. The teachers trained through the new program will be able to teach at Secondary and Higher Secondary Levels of inclusive and special education institutions and will be an equivalent of the existing master's degree as per HEC revised teacher education road map. After obtaining the degree, prospective teachers will be eligible for admission to M. Phil (Special Education).

Objectives

B.Ed 1.5 in Special Education programme is aimed to:

1. Introduce the field of special education with its diversity and technicalities.
2. Equip the trainee teacher with necessary knowledge and expertise to excel in the field of special education,
3. To develop the competencies of trainee teachers for the educational assessment and management of children with special needs
4. To highlight the multidimensional role of special educators for research and development in the field of special education.

Eligibility Criteria

- 16 years of Education i.e. B.S Hon/MA/M.Sc/ B.S (4-Year) etc. with 45% marks.

B.Ed. (2.5 years) program has significant importance and a wide scope. B.Ed. (2.5 years) program allows prospective teachers to develop an in-depth understanding of teaching methodologies, curriculum and instruction, and classroom management. Graduates with B.Ed. (2.5 years) program can contribute to designing and revising curriculum materials, ensuring they are relevant, effective, and aligned with the educational goals. They

can pursue their career as school teachers. With the knowledge of pedagogy and educational theories, the graduates can work as educational consultants. They can advise schools, educational institutions, and government bodies on educational practices, curriculum development, and teacher training. B.Ed. (2.5 years) program emphasizes action research skills, which are valuable for conducting educational research and contributing to the improvement of teaching and learning practices. The graduates can also provide private tutoring services, especially for subject-specific coaching through online or face-to-face mode.

Introduction: Distance education has primarily enabled students to develop technical skills, approach problem solving more pragmatically, and to learn information while remaining at their homes/workplaces. B. Ed (4 Years) Distance and Non-formal Education gives prospective teachers the flexibility to study online. This program is aligned with Undergraduate Education Policy (2023) of HEC. This revised scheme will impart andragogical and pedagogical knowledge, practical skills, and professional training to enable prospective teachers to creatively contribute to the social, cultural, and educational development of a globally oriented, pluralistic, and diverse society. This program focuses on education and training of prospective teachers who grow out of a profound belief in the transformative power of education. It will not only provide a

direction to general education but will also ensure that those who intend to opt teaching as a profession will be offered general courses, interdisciplinary courses, practical field experiences, and a capstone project. This will equip prospective teachers with essential professional skills, knowledge, values and a professional attitude to meet the educational demands in their career avenues.

Objectives:

Following are the objectives of B. Ed (4 years) Distance and Non-formal Education program:

- To foster continuous professional development and skills training.
- To equip the prospective teachers with subject knowledge and relevant pedagogical and andragogical skills, and dispositions to be teachers at secondary, higher secondary and NFE sectors.
- To enhance personal, professional, and social integrity of prospective teachers.
- To strengthen the ideological perspectives of students adequately and properly.
- To foster necessary research skills to play constructive role in classroom practices.
- To provide the opportunity to prospective teachers to enhance personal growth i.e., improve linguistic skills, communication, communication skills, and critical thinking etc.

Eligibility Criteria

Minimum entry requirement for admission is as follows:

- iv. A course taken by any student cannot be changed during the semester. However, in real hardship cases, the change in courses will be allowed before the start of study period after depositing of prescribed fee. The study period is available in academic calendar on AIOU website please.
- v. The address of a student will not be changed during the semester.
- vi. On payment of the registration fee, each student will be issued a student ID. This number must be quoted in all the future correspondence along with the roll number, course(s), code numbers and semester.
- vii. Study material shall be available at the LMS (Aaghi Portal) and AIOU Website.
- viii. After confirmation of admission students are usually intimated about the part time tutors for each course through student CMS portal. If you do not find information about tutors, you are required to contact the concerned AIOU Regional Office immediately without any delay.
- ix. Rules and regulations framed, enhanced and changed from time to time by the authorities, bodies of the university will be effective as deemed necessary. The student will have to abide by all such rules and regulations from the date of their implementation.
